Time Commitment:

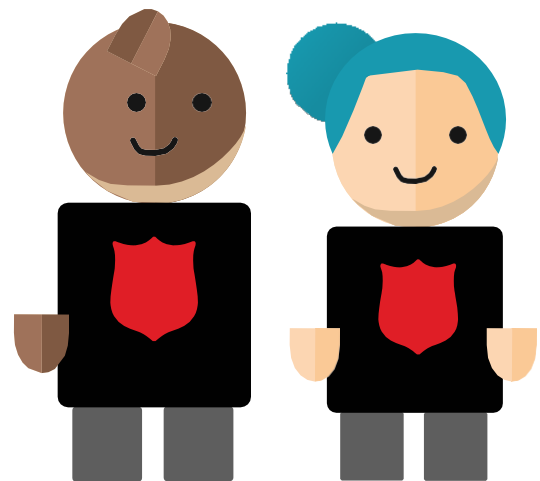
- Dates/times vary according to program area

The work environment is typically agreeable at work site both within residential setting as well as outside and may require working under the following conditions: dealing with potentially disagreeable participants.

Role Purpose Summary:

Provide musical entertainment and/or accompaniment, promoting the positive wellbeing of the residents and program participants.



Key Accountabilities:

- Playing a musical instrument once a month or more (e.g. for weekly Chapel) as per volunteer availability
- Repertoire could include traditional hymns/familiar favorites to be played while our residents/program participants sing along.

Qualifications:

- Ability to play an instrument; comfortable playing/singing in front of a group
- Patient, positive disposition and a willingness to help others
- Good, clear communication skills
- Ability to initiate and maintain conversation while maintaining professional boundaries
- Familiarity with vulnerable populations an asset (mental health, addictions, homelessness).
- Police Information Check with Vulnerable Sector Check and references mandatory for this position
